

# Requesting Housing Accommodations



## WHAT ARE HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS?

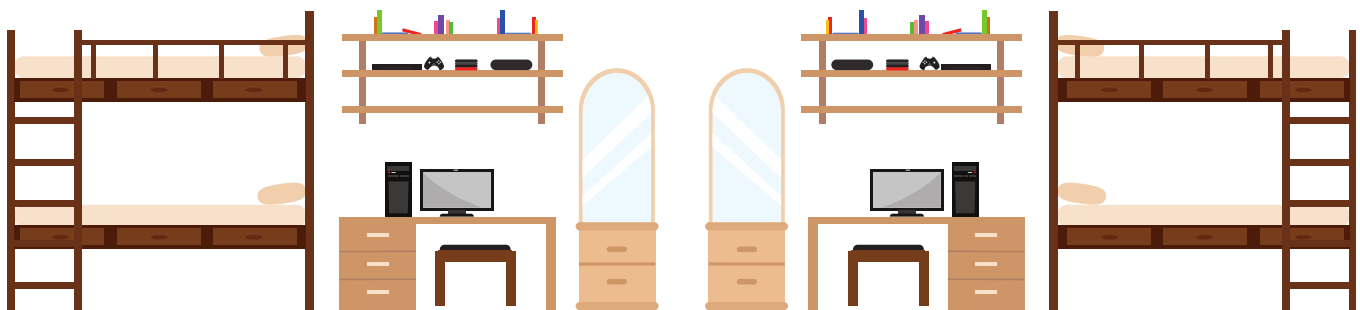
"To fully engage in campus programs and activities, students with disabilities might need adjustments to their housing setup.

## WHO QUALIFIES FOR ACCOMMODATIONS?

Students with documented disabilities who reach out to the university's accessibility office may be eligible for housing accommodations. These are determined on a case-by-case basis, based on each student's unique needs, experiences, and disability-related limitations."

## HOW DO I GET STARTED?

- Complete the Housing Accommodation Request Form.
- Meet with a representative from the Office of Accessibility Services
- Watch for an email with your accommodation decision.
- You'll receive a letter confirming whether your request has been approved or not.
- If approved, OAS will coordinate with other offices—such as Residence Life and the Business Office—to help implement your accommodations.
